- ★ **Statue of Mars – the finest Roman statue in Britain**
This is a stunning life-size statue of the Roman God of War - wearing full armour and carrying a shield. He has a sword on his hip and in his other hand he probably would have been carrying a metal spear.

Mars was the God of War and the Roman legions worshipped him throughout the Roman Empire. He was the legendary father of Romulus (the founder of Rome) and the son of Jupiter.

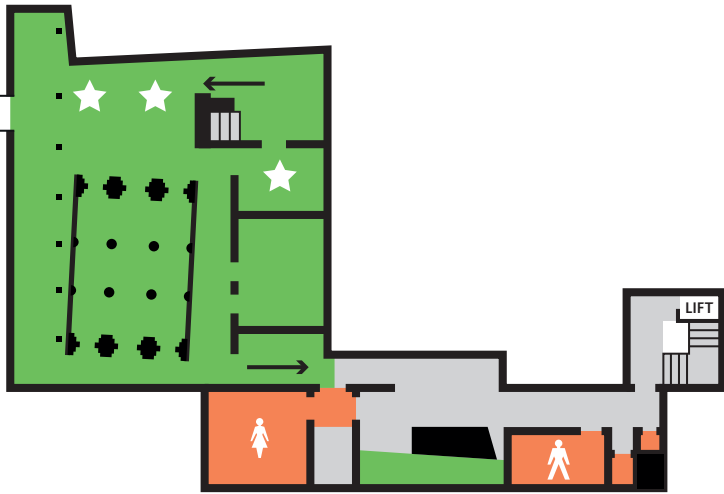

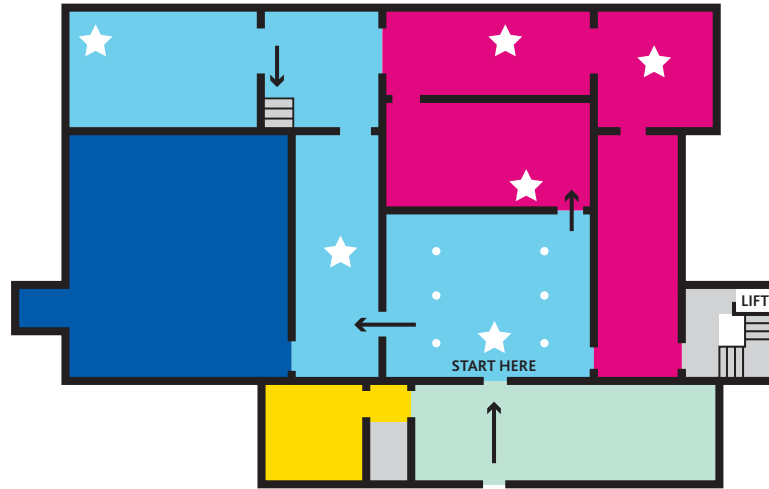

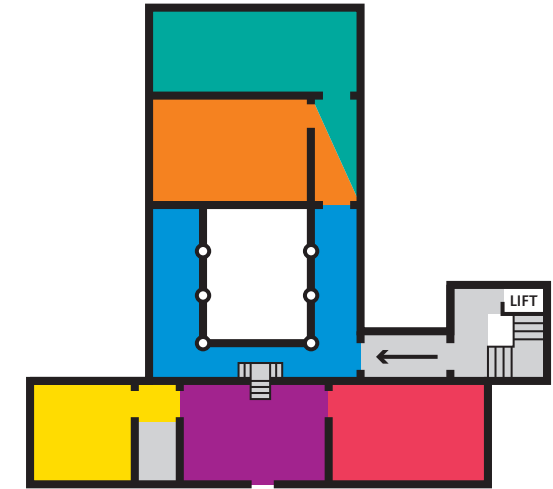
